Each submission must include a consent under Data Privacy Act 2012, a nickname or pseudonym (optional for anonymity), and a full written narrative.

The Information Dissemination Committee will conduct an initial screening for appropriateness.

Objectives

1. To give QCians a creative and welcoming environment in which they may express themselves, as well as their own experiences, reflections, and stories.
2. To honor student experiences— Emphasize the various paths, struggles, and victories of QCU students, encouraging a genuine, compassionate, and understanding culture within the campus community.
3. In order to increase student involvement, plan storytelling events with a theme that corresponds with holidays like Valentine's Day and Halloween.
4. By highlighting common experiences that capture the ideals, challenges, and pride of being a QCians, educators may strengthen bonds between students and promote a sense of cohesion and belonging.
5. To assist SSC's communication efforts— Provide a channel for the Supreme Student Council to establish a more meaningful, intimate, and personal connection with the student body.

All content released under this initiative shall abide by the university's communication policies, ethical standards, and content guidelines to ensure that materials remain inclusive, respectful, and representative of the QCU student body. Approved stories will be featured across the official SSC Facebook and Instagram pages.
