In line with the **Quezon City University Supreme Student Council** in collaboration with **QCU Peer Counselor's** commitment to fostering unity, inclusivity, and student engagement through meaningful on-ground initiatives, the council is launching **"KYUSInong Para Sa'yo: A QCU Valentine's Day Special"**. This event is designed to provide QCians with a safe and interactive campus experience that celebrates connection, self-expression, and diverse relationship journeys.

The Valentine's Day Special features student-centered activities such as a Love Question, a Photobooth, and the Pixel Heart Board, each encouraging respectful interaction, emotional expression, and participation in a fun and welcoming environment.

All students are expected to participate voluntarily and observe proper decorum, respectful communication, and appropriate behavior during the activities.

Love Question (15 Minutes): A registration fee of **30 pesos** per participant.

Photobooth: Souvenir photo strips are available at **50 pesos** for one strip and 70 pesos for two strips.

Fundraising Allocation: Fifty percent (50%) of the collected fees from this fundraising activity shall be allocated to support the QCU Robotics Team.

Objectives

1. Provide QCians with a safe, inclusive, and engaging on-ground Valentine's Day experience that encourages positive social interaction and emotional expression.
2. Facilitate meaningful yet respectful connections among students through a structured Speed Dating activity guided by clear mechanics and conduct standards.
3. Offer creative and memorable student experiences through interactive booths such as the Photobooth, allowing participants to capture and commemorate their Valentine's Day moments on campus.
4. Encourage self-reflection and emotional awareness among students through the Pixel Heart Board, which visually represents diverse relationship statuses and personal journeys in a collective and non-judgmental manner.
5. Promote QCU SSC-led student engagement initiatives that strengthen campus community, participation, and inclusivity across all Quezon City University campuses.
