A Resolution Proposing the Authority to Direct the Immediate Posting and Dissemination of Urgent Emergency Service Announcements Through the Official Social Media Pages of all Recognized Student Organizations Without Prior Approval from the Student Affairs and Services Department (SASD), Subject to the Approval of the Appropriate University Authorities

WHEREAS, Quezon City University recognizes the need for timely dissemination of verified emergency information to protect the safety, security, and welfare of the University community;

WHEREAS, the official social media pages of recognized student organizations provide accessible communication channels that can assist in reaching students promptly during emergencies;

WHEREAS, requiring prior approval for time-sensitive emergency announcements may delay the dissemination of information necessary for immediate student response and safety;

WHEREAS, the proposed authority shall apply only to verified and urgent emergency service announcements issued by the University, its authorized offices, or competent authorities;

WHEREAS, the proposed measure shall establish a clear distinction between urgent emergency announcements requiring immediate dissemination and regular University communications that remain subject to existing approval procedures;

WHEREAS, appropriate safeguards are necessary to ensure the accuracy, consistency, and accountability of information disseminated through recognized student organization platforms;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROPOSED, that Quezon City University authorize the immediate posting and dissemination of **verified urgent emergency service announcements** through the official social media pages of all recognized student organizations without prior approval from SASD, subject to the approval of the appropriate University authorities;

PROPOSED FURTHER, that only official and verified emergency announcements issued by authorized University offices or competent authorities shall be disseminated under this authority;

PROPOSED FURTHER, that recognized student organizations shall post such announcements in their official and unaltered form and shall not independently issue or modify emergency directives;

PROPOSED FURTHER, that the appropriate University authorities shall establish guidelines on verification, scope, accountability, documentation, and post-publication coordination with SASD and other concerned offices;

WITNESS OUR HANDS this 9th day of March, 2026, Quezon City, Philippines.

PROPOSED FINALLY, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the appropriate authorities of Quezon City University.

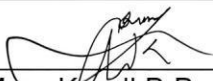
